



Le Mauricia : a new Wellness Centre

Le Mauricia unveiled its new Wellness Centre on the 1st of July 2008. This new facility is the last in a series of new amenities that have been introduced at Le Mauricia during the past year and a half, which include new Apartments, new restaurants and Honeymoon Suites with private pools. A truly unique facility for a 4-star resort, the Wellness Centre, set apart from the hotel's hub, has also been designed to create another venue for guests to socialize in a serene environment.

The architectural concept of the new Wellness Centre draws from a number of Mediterranean influences.

Hence, terracotta roofs, pergolas and the sandy shade chosen for the exterior are all in keeping with the traditional Mediterranean design which is Le Mauricia's signature style.

Evoking the ambiance of a Moroccan medina, the Wellness Centre's structure revolves around 10 cabins linked together by a series of arches opening onto a symmetrical reflection pool.

The cabin interiors have been designed to recreate the serene ambiance of Asian Spas.

The glass-fibre roofs evoke a « tent effect » which makes the rooms seem larger, yet comfortable and warm. Walls are painted in different shades of grey, reflecting a sense of cool sophistication and modernity, set off by bold paintings representing Buddhist influences in yellow, pink, orange, red, gold or silver.

Complementing the modern look are natural elements such as wood, black stone and pebbles.

New facilities include :

- 10 cabins
 - 9 single cabins (including 1 cabin dedicated to shirodhara)
 - 1 double cabin

Adjoining the Wellness Centre, the Sports Centre has :

- One cardio room
- One fitness room
- One hammam
- One sauna
- 3 tennis courts
- One HEAD Pro-shop
- Dressing rooms
